RESOLUTION


The Kendall Federation of Homeowner Associations (“KFHA”) requests the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners (“BCC”) help reduce congestion in the Kendall area and authorize a pilot study by providing free Bus/ Metrorail Passes to residents of Kendall (SW 40th Street to SW 152nd Street, 87th Avenue to Krome Ave.) for 2 months and study ridership prior to and after the Passes are provided.

Currently, there are studies and workshops in action presenting various mass transit solutions for Kendall Drive that all cost hundreds of millions of dollars. While the KFHA is certainly in favor of “doing something”, we are concerned that the car culture is too great and people will not give up their cars for any mass transit.

Therefore, the KFHA Board unanimously voted to encourage the BCC to try this experiment and see if free rides, along with a marketing campaign to get people out of their cars, will create any significant decrease in traffic. Let’s see if current, mass transit can perform better before we spend those hundreds of millions of dollars.
